Female feticide is the process of ascertaining the sex of the fetus and conducting an abortion when a girl child is born. Our organization is doing Jagan Jagan Awareness Camp against this so that people are aware and do not get female foetus. Female feticide is illegal, yet many people continue to practice it. In addition, there are some communities that practice female feticide The practice of killing a girl child after her birth. Some of the causes of female feticide include son preference, low status of women, social and financial security attached to sons, socio-cultural practices including dowry and violence against women, small family norms and Consequential misuse of diagnostic techniques with intent to kill female foeticide. The cause of female feticide in India is the overwhelming belief that women have less social value than men. Lack of education among women, inadequate female leadership and negative perception of women as an "economic burden" contribute to this view.

CYCLONE "YASS" DRY FOOD DISTRIBUTE

West Bengal-based NGO "ISWAR CHANDRA VIDYASAGAR RURAL DEVELOPMENT ORGANIZATION", launched a massive relief operation for the victims of Cyclone Amphan, which devastated various districts of West Bengal last month. The relief package included clothes, groceries, rice, spices, pulses, medical kits, etc. for men, women and children. Team of " ISWAR CHANDRA VIDYASAGAR RURAL DEVELOPMENT ORGANIZATION " went on the ground with relief material and covered most of the affected villages of "Nadia". So far more than 700 families have benefited from this campaign.

Our ngo organized health awareness camp about COVID 19 in which people were told about health related things to avoid covid pandemic and made people aware, asked to maintain social distancing, whenever out in any public place, So always told to wear facemask and cover your mouth while coughing and sneezing - you have to cover your mouth with tissue even while coughing or sneezing. If we want to be around people, we were asked to keep a distance of 2 meters or 6 feet from the people around us as much as possible] Not only mass gatherings, but also shopping malls, stadiums and movie theaters, all of us were asked to take precautions. Our Organisation Organish eye Camp. In this camp, the people were given free eye checks along with the facility of their medical. It is completely free for patients In these eye camps basic services were provided such as screening and correcting refractive errors by providing eye glasses, providing medicines to address allergy and other eye conditions, identification of cataract and other surgical cases.

Our organization organized the 161st birth anniversary function of Rabindranath Tagore. Tagore Jayanti is an annual cultural festival celebrated among Tagorephiles (people who love Tagore and his works) in the Nadia district of West Bengal to commemorate the birth anniversary of Rabindranath Tagore. Rabindranath Tagore was born on 7 May 1861 in Jorasanko Thakurbai, Kolkata. Our NGO has organized many cultural programs to celebrate Rabindra Jayanti. Our organization organized WOMEN TRAFFICKING AWARENESS camp, in this event our organization is making women aware against trafficking. Our organizations search for traffickers who are most susceptible to coercion in the human trafficking industry. They are migrants who flee their homes due to economic hardship, natural disasters, conflict or political instability, while the most well-known forms of human trafficking are for the purpose of sexual exploitation, the trafficking of hundreds of thousands of victims into forced labour, domestic slavery, Children are used to beg or to remove their parts.



SANITARY NAPKIN DISTRIBUTION PROGRAM

Our NGO did sanitary napkin distribution program in which sanitary pads were distributed to women and girls in rural areas. Hygiene is important for everyone, helps in maintaining health and prolonging life span. This is especially important for children. Worldwide, more than 800 children under the age of five die every day from diarrhea-related diseases caused by a lack of water, sanitation and hygiene. The function of sanitary napkins is to absorb and retain menstrual fluid and To separate the menstrual fluid from the body.



RURAL POOR ARTIST STUDENTS CAMP

Our organization organized the program of rural poor artist student camp, in this program the poor children of the community participated / The purpose of this program was to bring creativity in the children An artist is defined as a person who does painting, sculpture, writing. Manufactures pieces, music, dance or other types of creative products. Some examples of famous artists are Van Gogh, Picasso and Michelangelo.



PREVENTION OF CHILD MARRIAGE CAMP

Our NGO Organized Awareness Against Child Marriage, West Bengal State . Child marriage refers to any formal marriage or informal union between a child below the age of 18 years and an adult or any other child. Child marriage ends childhood. It negatively affects the rights of children to education, health and safety. A girl who is married as a child is more likely to drop out of school and not earn money and contribute to the community. He is more likely to experience domestic violence and be infected with HIV/AIDS. Child Marriage Prohibition Act 2006 has been implemented in India to prevent the practice of marriage of children at a young age. In which the age of the boy is less than 21 years and the age of the girl is less than 18 years, then they are not eligible for marriage. If at the time of marriage either the boy or the girl is not of marriageable age, then such marriage is considered an offense as child marriage.

SARSWATI PUJA FESTIVAL

Our organization celebrated Saraswati Puja Festival Saraswati Puja: On the occasion of Basant Panchami, the goddess of knowledge and wisdom, Saraswati is worshipped. Also known as 'Vasant Panchami', it is an important Hindu festival in India that marks the arrival of spring. It prominently colors the surroundings yellow.
