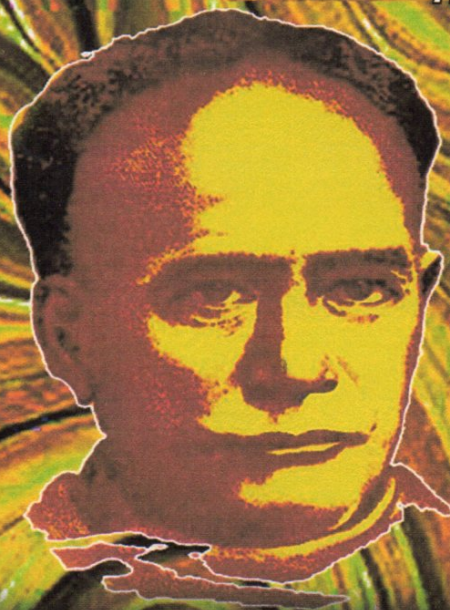

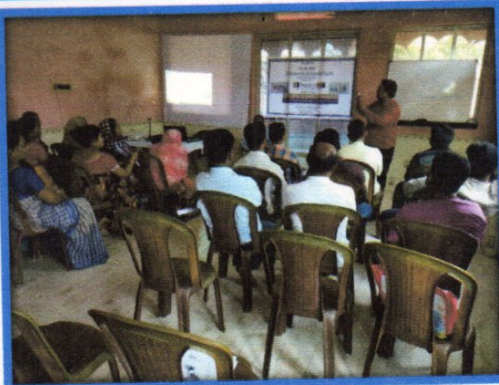
TAILORING TRAINING PROGRAMME

THALASSEMIA

Among the various diseases that affect children, thalassemia is the most dangerous, posing serious risk to their survival. It is caused through genes in a child inherited from its parents. Surprisingly, there is no cure for this blood disorder affecting children but it can be prevented.



According to Dr K.Battachariya , a renowned physician, "the majority of children born with thalassemia in India die undiagnosed or due to lack of proper treatment.

As the therapy of thalassaemia is expensive and beyond the reach of many patients, a government sponsored national programme is needed for prevention, screening of high risk population, counselling and prenatal testing”.

It causes devastating impact on the health of the patients and finances of their families as the patients require life-long blood transfusions. In other words, the thalassaemic child leads a borrowed life depending on blood transfusions and chelation therapy for iron overload.

The beauty of blood donation lies in the fact that the recipient does not know the donor generally. An unseen, real hero saves a life. It is the greatest service to the suffering people.

To quote Kahlil Gibran, “You give but little when you give your possessions. It is when you give of yourself that you truly give”.

Due to the negligence of parents, the “bundle of joy” becomes a “burden” on them. They have to take their baby to hospital regularly for blood transfusions and this causes mental trauma as they see their child pricked with needles frequently.

They feel that in spite of giving expensive treatment, they are helpless to bail out the child. Thalassaemia not only affects children, it also creates psychological and social problems in the family.

The disease is spreading because of ignorance of people. Therefore, creating awareness is the need of the people. Although every year on 8th May , World Thalassaemia Day is celebrated all across the world, the common man is not aware of this disease.

Thalassaemia is known to be more dangerous than polio. Not only thalassaemic children and their parents or NGO workers but people from all walks of life should join hands to make the world thalassaemia-free.

When in cities, people are not familiar with the disease, one can imagine the fate of unfortunate children of the rural areas. According to the National Health Mission, there are about 700 million people living in 6 lakh villages in India. Most states lack in medical facilities in rural areas to treat the diseases.

Although many projects, including the Child –Health Programme was launched in the Fifth Plan Period, the situation in rural areas has not improved.

Unlike cities, most of the primary health centres in rural areas neither have child specialists nor can provide basic medical facilities for children.

According to Dr S. Mukharjee of the Globle Hospital , Krishnanagar ,Nadia,W.B, has more number of thalassaemic children than other states.

The main reason is lack of awareness. She said, “electronic and print media can play a constructive role to prevent this disease”.

Here are a few suggestions to create awareness in society: At the time of marriage, the blood test of both the bride and the groom should be conducted. It is a sure way of eradicating thalassemia.

Gynaecologists can be very useful and effective in creating awareness in people and prevent thalassemia. They can include the test for thalassemia trait in routine check-up of pregnant women.

School text books should have a chapter on thalassemia. Blood donation camps can be held at schools and colleges.

An NGO in NADI,W.B. , CHCM (Thalassemia Awareness & Prevention in Nadia) , we can have feature films, dramas, stories, debates, and seminars educating the masses.

Posters and hoardings of thalassaemic children with a strong message can be displayed at airports, railway stations, shopping complexes, and places of worship. campaign can be carried out during local fairs and festivals as part of awareness creation



INTERNATIONAL WOMEN'S DAY

International Women's Day, originally called International Working Women's Day, is marked on March 8 in every year. The date is commemorated at the United Nations and is designated in many countries as a national holiday. The first national Women's Day was observed on 28th February 1909 in the United States following a declaration by the Socialist Party of America. In 1910, Socialist Second International woman's day held the first international women's conference in Copenhagen. 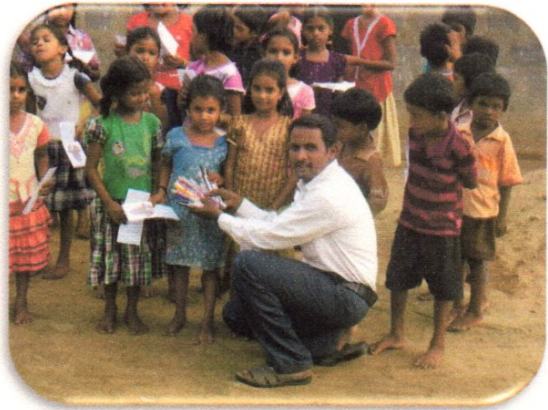

We have established orphanage home this year with the help of local people and the members of the organization. More than one hundred fifty local people have joined in the opening ceremony which was inaugurated by the honorable MLA Rukbanur Rahaman .



We run a home (orphanage) of 150 boys aged 5 to 16 years old from disadvantaged backgrounds providing them food, shelter and education. The home was founded in April 2015 with 30 homeless kids.

We provide a safe and secure environment for these vulnerable children. We strive to create a loving, family atmosphere, dedicated to helping the children build character and develop academically. The children have formed a close-knit loving family and have adjusted well to school where maintain high standards and good discipline.

We also offer Vocational Training of Computer Science for our children as well as local community who are not able to pay fees at other reputed institute.

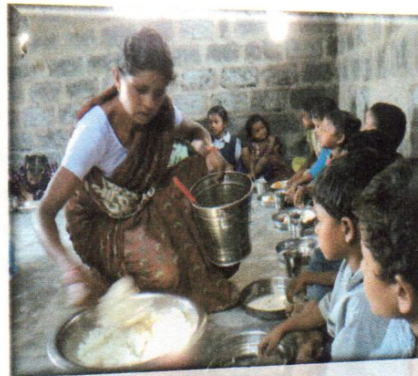
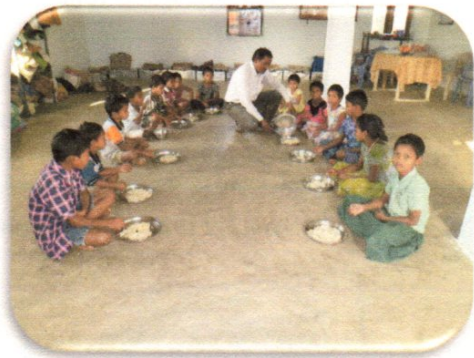
