1. *Education & children development*

➤ Free Education to Needy students

For development of Education of poor children a free coaching program has organized by the Organizations. And we also distribute some books & other study materials to the students.

As a volunteer at the ISWAR CHANDRA VIDYASAGAR RURAL DEVELOPMENT ORGANIZATION', we will be living in the happy establishment with the children. Volunteers help the children with their academic studies, play games, and most importantly, act as role models for these deprived children.



1) To maintain a safe and pleasant environment for the children and care for all their needs, including medical, education, and cultural. The children will attend school and receive classes in Bengali music and arts in order to strengthen cultural ties.

2) To promote and encourage the advancement of literacy. A free coaching center will be maintained at ISWAR CHANDRA VIDYASAGAR RURAL DEVELOPMENT ORGANIZATION Orphanage for street children.

3) To help the sick, aged, and destitute, the onsite dispensary will offer free medical treatment to people of all ages and religions in the community.

We have established orphanage home in 2020 with the help of local people and the members of the organization. More than one hundred fifty local people have joined in the opening ceremony which was inaugurated by the honorable **MLA Rukbanur Rahaman**.

We run a home (orphanage) of 150 boys aged 5 to 16 years old from disadvantaged backgrounds providing them food, shelter and education. The home was founded in April 2015 with 30 homeless kids.

From the very beginning to the end of the year some many parson an organization helped us .In this space we would to convey our gratitude to them specially honorable MLA Rukbanur Rahaman. I hope they will be helpful in future as they were before.



We provide a safe and secure environment for these vulnerable children. We strive to create a loving, family atmosphere, dedicated to helping the children build character and develop academically. The children attend Bengali Primary School Monday to Friday, with additional tutoring in the evening to help them with their homework. The children have formed a close-knit loving family and have adjusted well to school where maintain high standards and good discipline.



We also offer Vocational Training of Computer Science for our children as well as local community who are not able to pay fees at other reputed institute.

2. Covid-19 relief work

As we have mentioned above that our organization was started only to provide help to the people from the corona epidemic, but after coming to the ground level, it came to know that a lot of work needs to be done. The time when Corona came to India and strict lockdown was imposed at the national level, it became a time of great challenge for the people of poor and middle family. The migrant people had to face the most problems, mostly working class people, who used to earn and eat every day, they did not have anything in the name of savings, due to stoppage of work, they had to starve to death, They could not even go to their homes due to the shutdown of transport, many people had to set out on foot to go to their homes with their families, which made them more troublesome. At that time our organization was not registered, our members had formed a team at that time just to help the people - who could provide food to the needy people during the corona pandemic and help them reach their homes. During that time of crisis our members did a lot of work - contributing themselves, some even helping us, so that we helped the working class people, the people living on the roadside as much as possible.

Indian authorities need to urgently adopt measures to protect the country's poorest and most vulnerable people if COVID-19 containment and relief measures prove inadequate, Human Rights Watch said today. On March 24, 2020, the government announced a three-week nationwide lockdown to contain the spread of corona virus in the country.

The lockdown has already disproportionately hurt marginalized communities due to loss of livelihood and lack of food, shelter, health, and other basic needs. The government does have a responsibility to protect the health and well-being of the population, but some of these steps have left tens of thousands of out-of-work migrant workers stranded, with rail and bus services shut down.

D. PRODUCTION CENTER: A garment production centre has organized by the Organization 11 nos of women workers have already benefited by production and sale in this reported period.



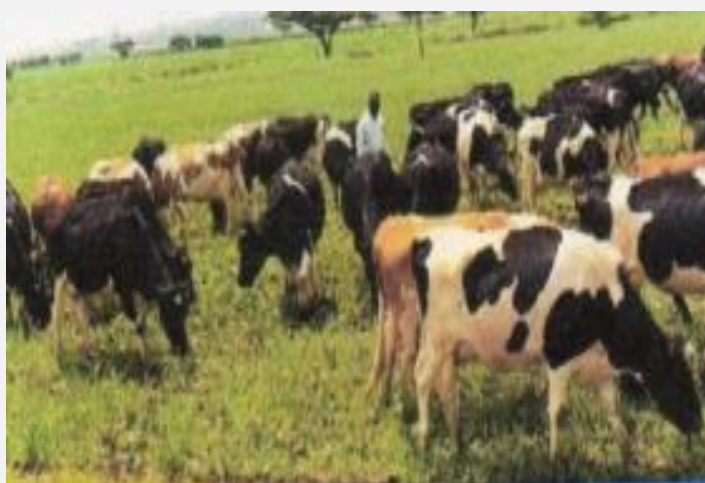
FISHING AGRICULTURE & POULTRY PROGRAMME

The fishing, agriculture and poultry Training programme has been organized by our organization for better development of fish, crops and bird making to the interested people of our locality.



ANIMAL WELFARE - The inhabitants of this locality are rural backward scheduled caste poor people. They live below poverty level line and deprived from education. They are not conscious regarding proper treatment of animal. Every year so many animals died in our locality. For this reason our organization has made an arrangement of a camp on animal welfare. Participants of **Chapra** Block were taken in the camp. Presents recourse persons were present and discussed vividly regarding different side of animal welfare. The activity of camp during the year was as under:

- A) No. of participants: - 127 nos.
- B) Duration of camp:- 1 day.
- C) No. Resource Persons :- 5 nos.



4. Healthcare & Awareness

Blood Donation Camp - The organization often arranged blood donation camp every year. We have organized a blood donation camps with the help of volunteers of grass root level and collect blood. Its main object is to help the poorest of poor in their different diseases in which blood is essential. Blood is donated with free of cost. It is an assistance program of poverty stricken family.



THALASSEMIA - Thalassemia (thal-uh-SEE-me-uh) is an inherited blood disorder that causes your body to have less haemoglobin than normal. Haemoglobin enables red blood cells to carry oxygen. Thalassemia can cause anaemia, leaving you fatigued.

Among the various diseases that affect children, Thalassemia is the most dangerous, posing serious risk to their survival. It is caused through genes in a child inherited from its parents. Surprisingly, there is no cure for this blood disorder affecting children but it can be prevented.

housing provided within the area of **Chapra Panchyat Samity** wherein it very much help towards the local people. Our origination built 50 low cost housing in this area.

One of the greatest achievements of our origination is the formation of S.H.G. and it's regular development. It's quite encouraging towards of our programme and also important in the socio economic development of the rural people mainly the worker section who are living under poverty line. Our origination



has made and arrangement of a camp of S.H.G. participants of different parts in chapra, Krishnagar 1&II block were taken part in the camp. So many recourse persons were present in the camp and discussed vividly regarding utility of S.H.G.

INTERNATIONAL WOMEN DAY CELEBRATION –

On the occasion, International Women's Day 2019 the Committee attention to the ISWAR CHANDRA VIDYASAGAR RURAL DEVELOPMENT ORGANIZATION hardship banished women tolerate. A Health check up camp for Aged person's Total 86 nos of beneficiaries has participated in those programs.

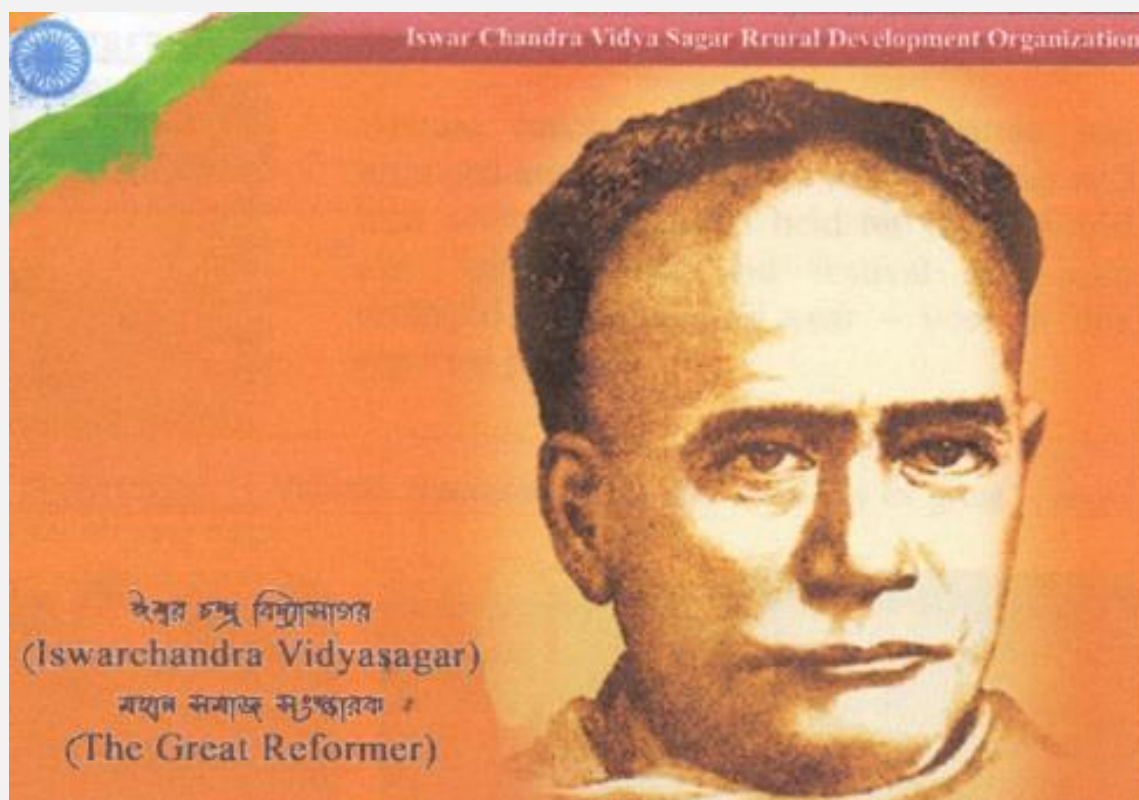
